- I started Sept. 10th with PV Water Coop meeting in Winkler. Water rates will increase by 2% in 2011 up to 6.53 per thousand gallons. Floride is still added to our water at .1 part per million . Roseau Reserve will be caught up with their bill again by end of this year. Yellow and red water was a concern to many when we switched over to the new plant in Morris .The new water totally rinsed out all water lines, taps and water heaters included. A major flushing program took place at the end of all lines. No problems that we have heard of since.
- Our regular meeting was on the 14th.
- On the 15th ,I attended the grand opening of our new water plant in Morris. It was good to see Murray and Don Roy took the time for the tour and gain a better understanding where our water comes from. It was disappointing that no one else from Roland seems to care as long as it comes out the tap on demand.
- The22nd started with John and myself meeting with Diane Toews. The time was well spent and we gave her a final cheque and thanked her for her 29 years of service to the municipality on behalf of all.
- The morning ended with a visit from Dept. of Highways. Bob Last and Glen Lawson. Brian stopped by to join in the discussion. They are looking at costs for putting another culvert through 23 highway to help ease the water problems in town.
