

BY-LAW NO. 11/80

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality  
of Roland to control the spread of  
noxious weeds.

WHEREAS Section 3(1) of the Noxious Weed Act states:


Each occupant of land, or , if the land is unoccupied the owner thereof, or the agent of the owner, and each person, firm, or corporation who or which is in control of, or in possession of, or in charge of, land, shall destroy all noxious weeds and noxious weed seeds growing or located on the land as often as may be necessary to prevent the growth, ripening and scattering of weeds or weed seeds.


AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the best interest of the inhabitants of the said municipality to control such weeds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Roland, in Council duly assembled as follows:

1. That the owner of land, or the agent of the owner of land located within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Roland shall mow all noxious weeds that grow on the road allowance adjacent to their lands, as well as their own lands.
2. That such weeds shall be mowed when instructed to do so by the Weed Inspector, but always prior to October 1, in each year.
3. That if such mowing is not done prior to October 1 in each year the Council of the Rural Municipality of Roland, shall cause such mowing to be done, and bill the person responsible for same, and if the bill is unpaid as at December 31 in the year in which the debt is incurred, such amount will be added to the tax roll and be collected in the same manner as taxes on the roll.
