

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROLAND

EY-LAW NO. 16/79

Being a by-law to restrict parking on highways within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Roland.


WHEREAS Section 86(1) of the Highway Traffic Act states in part that; Each traffic authority may classify vehicles according to dimensions, design, use, weight, kind of load carried, or otherwise; and for any class or all classes, may make rules supplementary to, or in addition to, but not contrary to, any other provisions of this Act, and applicable on highways over which the traffic authority has jurisdiction, with respect to (a) parking, stopping, and standing, of vehicles;


AND WHEREAS Section 198(2) of the Highway Traffic Act states; No person shall park or leave a vehicle so as to obstruct the free passage of traffic on a highway; but this subsection does not apply in respect of a vehicle that is so disabled that it is not practicable to avoid parking or leaving it temporarily on a highway.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Roland as follows:

1. No vehicle shall be left parked or standing on any highway within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Roland.
2. Any vehicle in contravention of this by-law shall be removed at the owners expense.
3. That any persons violating the provisions of this by-law shall be charged under section 195 of the Municipal Act.
