

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROLAND

BY-LAW NO. 3/79

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Roland respecting litter.

WHEREAS Regulation MR 259/74, being a regulation under the Clean Environment Act respecting litter states:

1. Definitions

In this regulation

(a) "Litter" means

- (i) rubbish, garbage or waste materials, including but not limited to containers, packages, bottles, cans or parts thereof, but excluding liquid wastes, and
- (ii) any deserted or discarded article, product, or goods of manufacture, but not including wastes of the primary processes of mining, logging, sawmilling, farming or manufacturing and "littering" has a similar meaning;

(b) "Litter Receptacle" means a container in which the public may deposit litter;

(c) "Public Place" means any area that is used or held out for use by the public whether owned or operated by public or private interests;

2. Unlawful activities.

(a) No person shall dump, deposit, drop, throw, discard or leave, or cause or permit the dumping, depositing, dropping, throwing, discarding, or leaving of litter upon any public or private property, or upon or into any body of water unless:


- (i) said property is designated by the local authority having jurisdiction for the disposal of litter, and such litter is disposed of in accordance with the rules and regulations pertaining thereto; or
- (ii) said litter is placed into a litter receptacle; or
- (iii) said litter is deposited in a location designated for this purpose by municipal authorities during special clean-up days; or
- (iv) said person is involved in an emergency situation.

(b) No owner or tenant in control of real property shall allow litter to accumulate upon that property in such a manner as to be unsightly or in such a manner that said litter may be blown or otherwise carried by the natural elements onto the real property of another person, or onto public property.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED

1. That no person shall deposit any litter except in areas so designated.
2. That no person shall allow litter to accumulate upon their property in such a manner as to be unsightly.
3. Any person, firm or Corporation who violates, contravenes or fails to observe and carry out any of the provisions of this By-Law shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs or to an imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days or to both such fine and imprisonment as provided in the Municipal Act, Section 740.
