

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROLAND

BY-LAW NO. 4-2009

**Being a By-Law of the R.M. of Roland
to establish fees for fire safety inspections**

WHEREAS, *The Fires Prevention and Emergency Response Act*, C.C.S.M. c. F80, requires that a municipality enforce the *Manitoba Fire Code* and inspect prescribed buildings;

AND WHEREAS *The Fires Prevention and Emergency Response Act*, Section 7(6) authorizes a municipality to charge a fee for carrying out fire safety inspections;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the R.M. of Roland, in meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. THAT the fees payable to the R.M. of Roland for fire safety inspections shall be:
 - a) Initial inspection \$250.00 plus mileage
 - b) Follow-up and subsequent inspections \$150.00 plus mileage
 - c) Contracted inspections Actual cost plus mileage
2. THAT Council may from time to time, by resolution, amend the fees payable for fire safety inspections.
3. THAT fees for fire safety inspections may be collected by the Municipality in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under *The Municipal Act*.
