

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROLAND

BY-LAW NO. 9/82

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE GARBAGE PICKUP

WHEREAS Section 338(1) of the Municipal Act states in part:

338 (1) The Council of any municipality may pass by-laws

- (a) for defining and classifying night soil, sewage, liquid waste, garbage, ashes, or other refuse;
- (b) for establishing, regulating, and maintaining, a scavenging system, in the whole, or any designated part, of the municipality;
- (c) providing for the collection, removal, and disposal of night soil, sewage, or liquid waste, or of garbage, or of ashes, and other refuse, throughout the whole municipality or in designated areas of it;
- (f) for providing that the cost of the system established under clauses (b) and (c) be borne (ii) if the system is in operation in a part only of the municipality, by a special tax on the owners or occupiers of the lands in respect of which the service is rendered;

AND WHEREAS Section 567 of the Municipal Act states in part as follows:


- 567 (1) The following amounts, that is to say
- (d) the amount of all rents and charges for (ii) work or services done or performed in respect of, that land; are a lien and charge upon that land, and shall be added by by-law, to the taxes shown on the tax roll to be charged and levied against the land and collected in the same manner in which ordinary taxes upon the land are collectable, and with the like remedies.

AND WHEREAS the residents of L.I.D. #1 in the Rural Municipality of Roland have made known to Council that they are desirous of having garbage pickup;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Roland as follows:

1. THAT garbage pickup be established within the limits of L.I.D.#1 on Tuesday of each week.
2. THAT garbage must be placed in garbage bags for residential properties and in garbage bags or boxes for commercial properties.
3. THAT each property shall be billed quarterly at the following rates:
 - (a) Residential - Sixty cents (.60¢) per week.
 - (b) Commercial - Sixty cents (.60¢) per week.and that any bill outstanding after thirty (30) days will be added to taxes on the roll and collected in like manner.
4. THAT burning of garbage and or other waste material shall be prohibited within the boundaries of L.I.D.#1.
