

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROLAND

BY-LAW NO. 21/79

Being a by-law to control the use of
Firearms and Fireworks, within the
limits of the Village of Roland and
the Village of Myrtle.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, Section 291(1) states:

The Council of any municipality may pass by-laws

- (a) for preventing or regulating the firing of rifles, guns, revolvers, pistols, pellet guns, and other firearms;
- (b) for preventing or regulating the use of catapults, slings, bows and arrows, and other weapons;
- (c) for preventing or regulating the firing or setting off of fireballs, squibs, firecrackers or other fireworks;
- (d) for regulating or prohibiting the sale within the municipality of fireballs, squibs, forecrackers and other fireworks to any person.

AND WHEREAS section 291(2) states:


A by-law passed under subsection (1) may be made applicable to the whole or any part of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to prevent the use of firearms, and control the use of fireworks, within the limits of the Village of Roland and the Village of Myrtle;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Roland as follows:

1. The firing of all rifles, guns, revolvers, pistols, pellet guns, and other firearms, and the use of catapults, slings, bows and arrows, and other weapons are prohibited within the limits of the Village of Roland and the Village of Myrtle.
2. The setting off of fireworks is restricted to the control of an adult.
3. The sale of fireballs, squibs, firecrackers or other fireworks is restricted to adults only.
4. That any persons violating any provisions of this by-law shall be charged under section 195 of the Municipal Act, whereby every person who contravenes, or refuses, neglects, omits, or fails to obey or observe, any provisions of any by-law of a municipality, is guilty of an offence and, if no other penalty is imposed therefor in the by-law, is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month, or to both such a fine and such an imprisonment.
